MESSAGE FROM THE VICE-CHANCELLOR AND PRINCIPAL

It is a great pleasure to welcome you all back from a well-deserved vacation. I also welcome those who are joining CUT only this year. Thank you for making the choice to turn your education into a 'CUT above the rest'.

The year 2015 was a year of great achievement in many respects in terms of our Vision 2020 and many other associated plans we have in place. Unfortunately, this space will not allow us to introduce all of these achievements. There are several important milestones we have reached in our academic project. All of the new STEPS¹ programmes have been implemented, which means qualifying students could enrol in some of the most relevant, responsive and high-quality programmes needed for the development of our region and country. One of the challenges universities of technology, in particular, face, is the alignment of their programmes to the Higher Education Qualifications Sub-framework (HEQSF), so that we have a unitary and articulated higher education system instead of the current binary system of traditional university programmes on the one hand and university of technology programmes on the other.

In this regard, a total of 26 new Category A² study programmes were approved for implementation in 2016 onwards, while an additional 38 programmes were aligned to the HEQSF, accredited by the Council on Higher Education (CHE), and approved by the Department of Higher Education and Training (DHET), also to be implemented in 2016. An additional 12 Category B³ programmes were aligned to the HEQSF, accredited by the CHE, and pending approval by the DHET, for implementation in 2017. A further 14 new programmes were cleared by the DHET and have since been submitted to CHE for accreditation. Moreover, the learning programme in Human Resources (HR) Management received provisional accreditation from the South African Board for People Practitioners (SABPP), which makes us one of only seven universities in South Africa to have received this accreditation.

We made remarkable strides in research and innovation, too. In August 2015, the Minister of Science and Technology, Ms Naledi Pandor, launched the DST/NRF Chair in Medical Product Development through Additive Manufacturing. Briefly, what this means is that CUT is a leader in the country in this area of engineering. At the National Research Foundation (NRF) Research Awards ceremony held in August, CUT was awarded the NRF Excelleration Award that acknowledges the most improved research performance over recent years. These acknowledgements of our research and innovation potential clearly makes CUT a leader in technology and innovation.

In our efforts to offer better services to our people, especially our students, we have considerably improved our academic services to students. The online application and registration processes are now in place. The iEnabler System now gives students convenient electronic access to information related to their studies (for example, registration, finances, progress reports, course marks and course verification) either over the internet or through CUT's intranet. The implementation of IComms has also been successful. IComms is a communications system that stores all prospective students' letters and makes these accessible to all

¹ STEPS is an acronym for Strategic Transformation of Educational Programmes and Structures, a curriculum and programme transformation programme that, in 2012, resulted in nine new demand-driven and user-oriented programmes. After a protracted approval process, the implementation of these programmes commenced in 2014.

² Category A programmes and qualifications require few or no changes to be aligned with the HEQF. Changes in this category would include an alignment in qualification type name such as "National Certificate" to "Higher Certificate"; a change in NQF exit level only; or alignment of the nomenclature to align with the naming style of the HEQF.

³ Category B programmes and qualifications require some curriculum development, but not so much as to constitute a 50% change to the programme structure, outcomes or total credits. The inclusion of required research credits, the differentiation between minimum and maximum credits at specific NQF levels within a qualification; and distinguishing between qualifiers and 'specialisations' or 'majors' may all be included as changes made to Category B programmes.

staff in Academic Administration, which has improved the turnaround time for responding to student applications.

In our quest to ensure that our students become employable graduates and, better still, to be innovators and entrepreneurs of note, CUT's 10 graduate attributes, currently being implemented, were launched on 22 and 23 April 2015, at both the Bloemfontein and Welkom campuses, respectively. In April 2015, the university embarked on an entrepreneurial education programme that will hopefully produce more job creators than job seekers over the next few years. A number of events and competitions focused on student innovation were held as part of this programme. In the near future, we will introduce some formal short and full programmes to ensure that our region prospers through innovation and entrepreneurship.

As a university that exists and operates within a community, we do our best to plough back into the community with various community engagement projects. In this respect, and with the support of many external organisations, CUT continues to contribute to the improvement of the quality of education in our schools as part of community engagement and socio-economic development of the region. The Saturday School project and our Winter and Spring Schools for matric students contribute immensely to the province's matric success rates. The Schools Advancement Academy continues to support the schooling sector in the Free State and enjoys the co-operation of the Free State Department of Education. The academy is in the process of being expanded so as to provide more support to schools. Through the merSETA Chair in Engineering Education, CUT provides support in science, technology, engineering and mathematics to the Technical Vocational Education and Training (TVET) colleges and other post-school education and training institutions.

The university continues to provide and nurture a healthy learning and living environment for both students and staff. The revamped university cafeteria now provides many healthier options to ensure our community's wellness. The construction of two gazebos at the open area in front of the Library and Information Services (LIS) Building, as well as the establishment of a coffee shop in the atrium of the BHP Billiton Building, were completed in 2015. The gazebos will house service providers that will provide food and beverages and seating for students and staff. It forms part of the greening of the campus environment as well as the creation of more blended learning and social spaces.

Over the past three decades, student accommodation has been a major challenge. This will soon be a thing of the past, as new residences in both Welkom (149 beds) and Bloemfontein (96 beds) will be completed early in 2016, courtesy of the DHET 3-300 project and financial support from the Department of Higher Education and Training and the university Council itself. Futher engagements are taking place with the private sector for more residences to be built. This will provide a much-needed relief.

To ensure the safety of our students on campus, the introduction of the Mag-touch device to monitor security patrols was a breakthrough against theft and crime on both campuses. Clocking points are placed in all buildings, along the fence and around areas where crime and theft are prevalent. These clocking points record and monitor the movement of security guards as well as of superiors each time a point is reached. In addition to this, the university has set aside millions of Rands for an integrated security system that will see more CCTV cameras and improved access control, amongst other security measures.

In closing, I would like to express my sincere gratitude towards our partners, staff and students for your commitment towards this institution. We count on your continued support in 2016 and beyond. With your support, we shall be unstoppable in our quest to help improve the quality of life in this region and beyond, and to truly make CUT "a cut above…"

HISTORICAL OVERVIEW

The Central University of Technology, Free State (CUT) is the foremost higher education institution in the heartland of South Africa, dedicated to quality education and training in Science, Engineering and Technology (SET). Over the past 35 years, CUT has developed into a leading institution, able to take its place in the national as well as international higher education landscape.

CUT, then still known as the Technikon Orange Free State, opened its doors in 1981 with 285 students enrolled in mainly secretarial, art and design programmes. In 2015, the university boasted 14 431 students who decided to make CUT their academic partner in earning a qualification and gaining appropriate workplace experience. With the restructuring of the higher education landscape some years ago, CUT embraced its new status as a university of technology (UoT), and thus positioned itself to succeed as such. On 26 March 2004, the former Technikon Free State officially exchanged its "technikon" status for a tailor-made identity when its new name was published in the *Government Gazette* – a name that is a true reflection of what the university stands for: Central University of Technology, Free State.

CUT's history – from its humble beginnings to the proud institution it is today – is reflected in its buildings. The unoccupied buildings of the Commercial High School in St George's Street, leased in 1981, soon became too small, and a second building in President Brand Street was occupied. In 1988, the university purchased the former premises of the Eunice Primary School and the campus of the Bloemfontein College of Education. Before long, these were followed by the Main Building (today known as the ZR Mahabane Building), the BHP Billiton Building (which houses a large portion of the Faculty of Engineering and Information Technology), the Dirk Coetzee Building (which houses the Faculty of Health and Environmental Sciences), the Prosperitas Auditorium, as well as the Boet Troskie Hall and a modern library. The Lapeng Student Centre is a hub of student activity that not only renders a valuable service with regard to the students' requirements, but also ensures that they enjoy every aspect of student life to the full. This centre is equipped with an amphitheatre, as well as a cafeteria where students can socialise.

However, it would be a pity if an institution's progress could be measured only by its state-of-the-art facilities. At CUT, progress and transformation go hand in hand. Within our new institutional culture, CUT can also be described in terms of the needs experienced within an African context. CUT boasts a diverse student community that is a true reflection of its demographic composition. The implementation of an Employment Equity Plan also guarantees that the academic and support services staff are representative in nature. In 2015, CUT employed 916 full-time as well as 1 124 part-time staff members.

CUT offers a wide range of qualifications in its four faculties, namely the Faculty of Engineering and Information Technology, the Faculty of Health and Environmental Sciences, the Faculty of Management Sciences and the Faculty of Humanities. The faculties recently underwent significant restructuring, leading to the creation of several new and exciting academic departments. More information on these new developments will be available in due course.

Since its inception, the institution has been aware of its social responsibility towards the broader community. The Science Park was established in 1999 to allow the community access to the institution's technology and applied research. The Science Park is in effect a bridge between CUT's expertise on the one hand, and the community that stands to benefit on the other. By making technology and expertise available to the entrepreneur, the development of new business in the region is encouraged and jobs are created.

The seat of the university is situated in Bloemfontein – in the heartland of South Africa – with a second campus in Welkom. All operations of the CUT Regional Learning Centre in Kimberley were incorporated into the National Institute of Higher Education: Northern Cape (NIHE: NC) as from 2010, following negotiations and the signing of a working agreement with the NIHE: NC, in view of collaborating with the Department of Higher Education and Training (DHET) on its policy for higher education provision in the Northern Cape Province. The CUT Registrar is a member of the NIHE: NC Board.

The Bloemfontein campus houses a full array of modern buildings with well-equipped laboratories and lecturing venues. Besides extensive Library and Information Services, the Lapeng Student Centre is a vibrant venue that hosts a wide variety of student activities and services. Excellent sporting facilities on campus cater for the needs of sport enthusiasts, who can choose from a host of formally organised sport codes, ranging from athletics, soccer, rugby and cricket, to basketball, volleyball and netball. In 2011, the Student Academic Support Centre on the Bloemfontein campus was completed. The construction of the Teacher Education Building, BHP Billiton Building (Faculty of Engineering and Information Technology) and Dirk Coetzee Building (Faculty of Health and Environmental Sciences) was completed in 2012.

Since the university's incorporation of the former Welkom campus of Vista University in 2004, particular attention has been paid to the development of its academic infrastructure and the Programme Qualification Mix. The campus also boasts state-of-the-art Library and Information Services and well-equipped lecturing venues. The Student Academic Support Centre and Teacher Education Building accommodates the UoT-type programmes that are gradually being phased in at this campus. Some sporting facilities, including a soccer field and tennis courts, have also been built. Additional lecture rooms were constructed and completed in 2012.

The institution refers to its students who have completed their studies as *practuandi* and not *graduandi*, because CUT students graduate with an academic qualification that not only testifies to a combination of theoretical and practical knowledge, but also allows graduates to enter the job market with prior experience in the industry – proof that they are fit for purpose. They have the foundation to be our country's new generation of forward-thinkers. We do not merely train students for jobs – we train students to think; to explore beyond the boundaries of today; to innovate; to imagine possibilities; to create; and to become agents of social change. CUT metamorphoses learners into leaders; amateurs into authorities; and pupils into professionals.





Subject A field of study in which CUT offers tuition.

Study unit The academic sections into which a subject is divided for tuition purposes,

e.g. module, paper, or research essay.

Continuous assessment

mark

The mark for each study unit composed of marks achieved in tests and other means of assessment other than the final assessment, calculated in

accordance with departmental policy.

Final assessment

(examination)

An approved unit of assessment that may occur at the end of a prescribed

study period.

Assessment (examination)

mark

The mark achieved in the final assessment (examination) of a study unit.

Final mark The mark calculated according to a prescribed ratio of the continuous

assessment mark and the assessment (examination) mark.

Pass mark A mark of at least 50% (except if otherwise stipulated in the faculty rules),

provided that the subminimum requirements have been met.

Subminimum A specified minimum mark to be achieved in the final assessment

(examination) in order to pass a study unit. A student who does not achieve the subminimum mark will fail the study unit, irrespective of the final mark.

Pipeline student A student who was registered for a Vista University programme prior to

2005, including a student who, in terms of the specified rules, must complete certain modules to graduate for a specific degree, diploma or

certificate.

Final-year student A student who can complete his/her qualification at the end of a particular

academic year.
