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1. FEES PAYABLE

The following fees must accompany the application form for admission:

Application fee (non-refundable):

Applications received before or on 31 August 2015 R200.00
Applications received between 1 September and 31 January 2015 R400.00

Boarding application fee:

Where applicable and only refundable if the person is not accepted as a student or is not placed in a residence

All students pay the following fees:

- Enrolment fee of R858, payable on enrolment
- Minimum tuition fee payment of R4 850.00 payable on enrolment

Over and above the fees mentioned above, a student who will be residing in a residence is also liable for the following fees:

 Minimum boarding fee of R2 200.00, payable on enrolment, plus the key and breakage deposits of R450.00 and R45.00.

Please refer to chapters 19 to 22 of this Fees Calendar for the total costs related to learning programmes and residence accommodation.

Conditions of payment

Undergraduate students:

The following conditions of payment are applicable:

i) Year students

A student enrolled for a year course is given 9 (nine) months in which to pay off his/her account (total registration fee for the year in equal instalments over 9 (nine) months), starting at the end of February of the current year of registration and drawing to a close at the end of October of the same year, subject to the opening of an account and signing of a monthly debit-order deduction instruction.

ii) Semester students

A student enrolled for a semester course will be allowed to pay off his/her outstanding debt for the semester in question in 4 (four) equal instalments.

The payment dates for the first semester are:



End of February (25% of the total registration fee) End of March (50% of the total registration fee) End of April (75% of the total registration fee) Full and final settlement due at the end of May

The above is subject to the opening of an account and the signing of a monthly debit-order deduction instruction.

The payment dates for the second semester are:

End of August (25% of the total registration fee)
End of September (50% of the total registration fee)
End of October (75% of the total registration fee)
Full and final settlement due at the end of November

The above is subject to the opening of an account and the signing of a monthly debit-order deduction instruction.

Postgraduate students (MTech):

Fees are payable over a two-year period and are adjusted to the increase applicable for the second year of enrolment, with an extension fee as applicable to the subsequent year of enrolment being charged of which the extension fee for 2016 will be R3650.

Postgraduate students (DTech):

Fees are payable over a three-year period and are adjusted to the increase applicable for the third year of enrolment, with an extension fee as applicable to the subsequent year of enrolment being charged of which the extension fee for 2016 will be R3650.

International students:

Foreign students (excluding those from SADC countries) are responsible for the regular payment of tuition fees, plus the portion of the government subsidy that is forfeited. Tuition fees are calculated at 50% of the normal fees charged.

2. INTEREST

All overdue accounts will be handed over to the attorneys for collections and any/all collection fees, legal costs and interest, as pre-determined by the attorneys, will be levied. No students will be allowed re-registration unless the total outstanding fees plus interest owed to the CUT have been settled in full.



3. RE-REGISTRATION

In a case where a student has not paid the full account with regard to a previous year of study, such a student will not be allowed to re-register before the account concerned has been paid in full, and provided that the payment is received before the deadline for registration.

4. METHODS OF ACCOUNT PAYMENT

4.1 Cash payments, credit card payments or payments by bank-guaranteed cheque

A discount of 10% (ten percent) is granted to any person who pays the tuition fee in full, and a discount of 5% (five percent) is granted to any person who pays the residence fee in full, in cash or by means of bank-guaranteed cheque, on enrolment / registration.

4.2 Direct bank deposits

Payments may be deposited directly into the CUT's bank account. The student's student number or identity number (if a student number is not yet available) must be given as the reference number on the deposit slip when the payment is made.

4.3 Bursaries / Loans

- 4.3.1 In cases where a bursary / loan covering the full or partial tuition and/or boarding fee has already been awarded to a prospective student, the letter in which the student is informed thereof must be attached to the enrolment form.
- 4.3.2 Over and above any other stipulations, a student will not be exempted from accepting responsibility for any payments owed to the CUT.

4.4 Payments by employers

In cases where an employer has already indicated that he/she is prepared to take responsibility for the payment of the full tuition and/or boarding fee, the student must include the letter giving notice thereof with the enrolment documents. In this letter the date(s) on which such payment(s) will be made must be mentioned, along with details of the specific fee(s) that will be paid by the employer, e.g. registration fee, tuition fee, boarding fee, etc.



5. CONDITIONS OF PAYMENT

5.1 Cash settlement

A discount of 10% (ten percent) is granted to any person who pays the tuition fee in full, and a discount of 5% (five percent) is granted to any person who pays the residence fee in full, in cash or by means of bank-guaranteed cheque, on enrolment / Feb 28.

6. REFUNDING OF FEES

6.1 Semester courses

The following percentages of fees are refundable, should a student discontinue his/her studies before or on the dates mentioned below by means of written notice on the prescribed form:

First-semester students:

Before or on 28 Feb	80%
Before or on 31 March	40%

Second-semester students:

6.2 Year programmes (full-time and part-time)

The following percentages of fees are repayable, should a student discontinue his/her studies before or on the dates mentioned below by means of written notice on the prescribed form:

6.3 Application fee

No application fee is refundable.

No application fee is transferable to another academic period.

6.4 Residence / Boarding deposit

The residence / boarding deposit is refundable in the following cases:

- If no residence accommodation is available; or
- If the applicant is not selected as a student.



6.5 Discount on tuition fee

In cases where members of the same family, who are not financially independent, are enrolled simultaneously as students at the CUT, the following discounts are granted:

Second family member: 15% Third and fourth family members: 25%

7.2 Cancellation of residence accommodation

In the CUT residences, namely Eendrag, Van Loggerenberg, Manheim Men, Mannheim Ladies, Welgemoed and Huis Technikon, the following rules apply:

• Accommodation is payable pro rata on a monthly basis, on the assumption that a student who has resided in the residence on the first day or any subsequent day of a particular month will be regarded as having resided in the residence for the entire month in question.

9. ERRONEOUS REGISTRATION

If the CUT admits an individual to, or registers an individual for, any degree or course and it later comes to light that the individual in question does not qualify for such admission / registration, that individual remains responsible for all fees (including but not limited to the registration fee, tuition fee and residence fee) payable as in the case of a student who cancels his/her studies, and is subject to the rules and regulations that apply in such a case.

10. DEFAULT OF PAYMENT

If a student fails to settle his/her account with the CUT, notwithstanding any other rights, the CUT is entitled to hand over the account to an attorney for collection. Students shall be held accountable for any/all collection fees and legal costs incurred during the collection of any amounts owed to the CUT. It is important to note that if any student fails to meet his/her financial obligations for the current or previous year(s) of study, all assessment results and the diploma or degree will be withheld.

11. REFUNDING OF DEPOSITS / CREDIT

Any deposit to be refunded is transferred to the student's tuition fee account. If a student's tuition fee account shows an outstanding balance, the deposit is credited to that account. If the tuition fee account shows a credit balance, the student concerned must apply for the refunding of the deposit by completing the prescribed form (form LS34), provided he/she is not a bursary holder. If there has been no application for the refunding of a particular deposit after a period of twelve months, the deposit is forfeited.

13. POLICY ON FINANCIAL AID TO UNDERGRADUATE STUDENTS AT THE CENTRAL UNIVERSITY OF TECHNOLOGY, FREE STATE

13.1 Policy Principles

13.1.1 Policy Objectives

The objective of this policy is to govern the effective management, of financial assistance, to undergraduate students at the Central University of Technology, Free State.

13.1.2 Definitions

- a) "Bursary" an outright grant made in respect of specified educational expenses.
- b) "Bursary/Loan" a single individual award of which a fixed percentage will be an outright grant and the balance repayable after the student leaves the CUT or is no longer registered as a student. Specific conditions are specified by the fund.
- c) "Entrant" for reference purposes, an entrant is a student who is registering at the CUT for the first time.
- d) "Financial Aid Students" awards from one or more sources, offered to supplement the student's family contribution and external funding, to the level necessary to meet basic costs.
- e) "Loan" money lent to the student to meet study-related costs, which must be REPAID. Interest is charged on loan funds.
- f) "Returning" for reference purposes, a returning student is a student who has previously been registered at the CUT.
- g) "Restricted Award" is an award on which the donor has placed restrictions, limiting it to a certain group of students.
- h) "Student" shall mean all students registered or wishing to register for an approved course of study at the CUT. This includes both entrants and returning students (including undergraduates and postgraduates) registering for a tertiary diploma or degree.
- i) "Academic Fees" include registration and tuition fees.
- j) "Surplus Funds" are funds paid into a student's fee account, which are in excess of his/her total financial obligation to the CUT.
- k) "NSFAS" stands for National Student Financial Aid Scheme.
- I) "BLFC" stands for Bursary and Loan Fund Committee.

13.1.3 Policy Statement



- a) The CUT has to balance the increasing financial needs of students against the diminishing financial resources of the CUT and those of external donors.
- b) To achieve this, the Financial Aid Department carries out functions that relate to the work of Academic, Student Services and Financial Management and Services, and should maintain a close working relationship with all three. Financial accountability is shared with Financial Management and Services, and the Financial Aid Department works very closely with the Student Debtors' Department in ensuring students are adequately funded.
- c) However, the prime focus of the Financial Aid Department is on students as individuals with specific needs. As our ability to meet students' funding needs from our own resources diminishes, we shall need to expand and improve our counseling and information service to students in addition to our evaluation functions.
- d) To govern the effective management of financial support available to students at the CUT, the Financial Aid Department has developed Manuals to:
- (i) Empower students;
- (ii) Develop a service that assists with financial deficits, establish an ongoing relationship with students and other components of the support network, and assist with the development of survival skills regarding financial responsibilities for the period of study at the CUT;
- (iii) Maintain a good working and service relationship with donors and determine mid-term operational objectives and procedures for the implementation thereof.
- e) This policy must be read in conjunction with the relevant Financial Aid Manuals.

13.1.4 Scope and Application of Policy

- a) Financial aid awards are subject to the availability of funds.
- b) This policy applies to all categories of funding except general sport bursaries, Innovation Fund bursaries and exemption of tuition fees for studies at the Central University of Technology, Free State.
- c) Where donors/bursaries have specific criteria with regard to their allocation, those criteria will take preference.
- d) All students and employees of the CUT must be familiar with this policy.
- e) Eligibility of Funding, Prioritization, Elements which make up the Package, Limitations on Funding, Extent of Funding and Disbursements

Refer to the relevant Financial Aid Manuals for details on the following:



- (i) The governing of the effective management of financial assistance to undergraduate students at the CUT;
- (ii) The academic and financial eligibility grounds when allocating funds;
- (iii) The prioritization when allocating funds (i.e. academic standing and the ranking in terms of need);
- (iv) The extent of funding and elements that make up the package (i.e. expected own contribution, costs that may be taken into consideration when making an award, the assessment of the funding package);
- (v) Limitations on funding (i.e. duration of funding, minimum and maximum awards and NSFAS loans);
- (vi) Disbursements to students, landlords, donors and other relevant parties.



13.2. CUT-ADMINISTERED BURSARIES

13.2.1 Academic Merit Bursaries

To be considered for such a bursary, a **first year** student must have scored at least 34 points in his/her Grade 12 examinations, as specified by the scale below. Only the six best subjects are considered. In order to qualify for these bursaries, a student needs to enrol for the full course load. Please note that Life Orientation subject is calculated at 1 points regardless of the highest mark obtained for the subject.

For senior students, academic merit bursaries are based on the achievements of students enrolled for at least four subjects (except where the curriculum determines otherwise).

The bursary is granted on condition that a 100% pass rate and an aggregated assessment mark of at least 70% is achieved in all courses with at least a pass rate of 75% in one of the subjects for which the student registered in the previous academic year or semester.

In accordance with the aforesaid condition, the amount allocated depends on the aggregate assessment mark.

Only registered students are considered for these bursaries.

13.2.2 Academic Recruitment Bursaries (for first-time entrants)

These are additional to the normal academic bursaries. To qualify, a student must score at least 34 points in his/her Grade 12 examinations.

The following categories are available:

Category A

- i. Each A symbol HG R 1,000.00
- ii. Each A symbol SG R 600.00

Category B

A bursary of R 1,000.00 will be awarded to a student who meets the following requirement: A score of 34 points, plus one or more distinctions, in his/her Grade 12 examinations, and enrolment in an Engineering, Information Technology, Health Sciences, Accounting or Education programmes.

Category C

Bursaries of R 10,000.00 each (subject to change) are allocated every year to the top ten first-time entrants. To be considered for this bursary a student must score a minimum of 42 points on the old notation scale and 90% on the new scoring scale (see above).

The completion of an application form is not necessary. The bursary will automatically be deposited into the student's fee account.

13.2.3 Sport Recruitment Bursaries

13.2.4 Deans Incentive Vouchers

These bursaries are additional to the normal merit bursaries available.

They are available in vouchers valued in denominations of R 1,000.00 and R 2,000.00.

The executive deans or their representatives will issue vouchers to prospective students as identified. These persons are accountable for all vouchers issued, as well as for the criteria used and the procedures followed.

14. Vice Chancellor's Prestige Awards for Student Excellence

- 14.1. These bursaries are administered by the Student Accounts, Bursaries and Loans Unit based on the following terms:
 - Students who have obtained distinctions in their subjects for the previous year's academic performance will be categorised into 3 categories namely Straight A students, Obtained distinctions 80% to 99% of the number of subjects enrolled and Obtained distinctions 70% to 79% of the number subjects enrolled,
 - Students must have at least registered for minimum four subjects with no failed subjects in the previous academic year,
 - The student must be a registered student to qualify for this funding,
 - The entire previous year's academic performance is considered,
 - If a student had already obtained bursary funding elsewhere which covers the entire study costs, an incentive will be awarded,
 - If a student terminates his or her studies, the bursary will automatically be terminated.



The following allowances per category will be awarded as follows:

Category 1: Straight A Students (Students who have obtained distinctions in all subjects)

- Tuition fees
- Residence fees (Private or on campus)
- Books
- Meals
- All study related costs

Category 2: Obtained distinctions 80%-99% on subjects enrolled

(Kindly note the allowances for this category will be more than category 3)

17. Other bursaries - externally related

- c) The delivery of specific services will differ from donor to donor. These services may include, but are not limited to, the following:
 - (i) Communication of required documentation between parties (proof of registration, student accounts, examination results, book allocations etc.);
 - (ii) Organisation of venues for interviews with students and assistance during interviews;
 - (iii) Identification of suitable candidates and screening of applications.
