LIS Age of Collection statistical report

- For the period October 2011 to October 2013 a total of 14,745 new library items were added to our collection for the Bloemfontein, Welkom and Kimberley Campuses.
- For material published in the decade 2010-2019 we were able the raise the bar as follows:
 - 10% of the Bloemfontein Campus Collection belongs to this period in comparison to only 2% two before.
 - 5% of the Welkom Campus Collection belongs to this period in comparison to only 2% two before.
 - 13% of the Kimberley Campus Collection belongs to this period in comparison to only 0% two before.


Investment into the STEM resources

- In 2011 the Bloemfontein Campus only had 170 books (a total of 2% of the total Bloemfontein Faculty of Engineering & IT Collection) that were published in the decade 2010-2019.
- This number improved to 437 books in 2012 (a total of 4% of the total Bloemfontein Faculty of Engineering & IT Collection).
- In 2013 this number escalated to 1162 (a total of 11% of the total Bloemfontein Faculty of Engineering & IT Collection).

A new "working room" opened. In time this will be developed into a fully-fledged "research common" facility for postgraduate students.





Databases the LIS subscribes to

- <u>EBSCOHost</u>: General database covering wide range of subjects, including company profiles.
- EBSCOHost Hospitality & Tourism complete: Covering hospitality & tourism.
- ISI Web of Knowledge Journal Citation Reports: View a journal's impact factor
- ISI Web of Science: Use it to identify a researcher's citations.
- **Labour Library**: Legal information
- LexisNexis Academic: Legal information
- **NETLAW**: Legal information
- Nexus: This database includes South African dissertations and theses. It provides information on all fields of science since 1919.
- <u>ProQuest Central</u>: General database covering wide range of subjects and a wide range of material types.
- <u>ProQuest Fulltext Dissertations & Theses Database</u>: The world's most comprehensive collection of dissertations and theses with nearly 3 million searchable citations to dissertation and theses since 1743.
- Refworks: An online research management, writing and collaboration tool allowing the user to administer the references via the Internet.
- <u>SA Citations Plus</u>: This group of databases provides extensive coverage of local and international information indexed by South African organisations.
- SA e-Publications: This database consists of 287 South African journal titles.
- <u>SA Gazette</u>: Legal information consisting of the Government Gazettes (from January 1994); the Provincial Gazettes (from September 1995) and the Parliamentary Bills (from January 1999)
- SA Law Reports: Legal information
- <u>SA Media</u>: One of the most comprehensive press cutting services offering you access to a database consisting of more than 3 million newspaper reports and periodical articles which have been indexed on computer since 1978.
