STUDY AT THE UNIVERSITY is

- the best Russian and international traditions of preparation of high qualified specialists at the internationally orient,
- the world known scientists and leading laboratories and schools of sciences for prior science, technic and technology trends,
- opportunity to study at the network universities of CIS and SCO as well as to attend modern programs designed in cooperation with the leading universities of the World,
- dual academic advising for magister and PhD programs.

The University is listed in Top 500 of Academic Ranking of World Universities and Top 100 of QS-BRICKS. Founded in 1960 the University is in Top 5 of the Russian universities ranking.

INSTITUTES, FACULTIES AND STUDENTS

The University has 20 Faculties and Academic Institutes. The teaching staff consists of 2500 lecturers and professors about 28000 students.

In Moscow campus there are about 20000 students 6500 of them are foreigners. Students from different countries found their national and regional associations. There are **more than 150** of such organizations.

ACADEMIC YEAR CALENDAR

The academic year is divided in 2 terms of 20 weeks. The first semester starts on September 1st and the second in February; students have vacations of 2 weeks in January and of 6 weeks in July-August.

STUDENTS CAMPUS

PFUR campus, the winner of Moscow Mayor Trophy "The most comfortable HEI territory".

The campus nowadays consists of 13 blocks of student hostels housing over 7 000 PFUR students and graduate students. PFUR campus has everything for comfortable life: disposal laundries, dry-cleaning and other ateliers, barber shop and hairdressing saloons, stores and shops, post-office, banks. Special reading-rooms are provided for a better preparation for studies.

The campus area is 50 hectares. The campus lies near a big green park and consists of 27 buildings – academic blocks, hostels, Medical Centre, sport facilities, shops.

Thirteen hostels have cozy rooms and equipped kitchens. There are laundries, dry cleaners, barber shops and European and Asian cuisines cafes to comfort students. All building are very close to each other.

The student campus is situated in the south-west of Moscow in one of the best places for study and leisure. The Hostels are situated in 5-storey, 16-storey and 18-storey buildings offering double and triple rooms, costing from 980 to 3500 conventional units per year including communal public services cost. water and electricity, furniture, cooking and washing facilities.

Student self-government organizations – like Student Councils – help students in different matters explain them their rights and musts.

MEDICAL CARE

The multipurpose health facility – Moscow Polyclinic No25 – is located in the campus to provide high qualified medical assistance. The clinic is up-to-date equipped and staffed with professionals.

All students, academic and administration staff are to pass annual medical survey within the frames of University's program "Students' Health". University Medical Centre provides regular health control and care covered by medical insurance which annual cost is \$270.

SECURITY

The site of the University Campus is fenced. The University Security includes guards, round-the-clock CCTV and fire alarm systems. Access to the University buildings is controlled by the electronic gate pass system. Local Police Station and the Department of Internal Security monitor public order and discipline on the campus territory.

SPORTS & LEISURE

To make students' life comfortable there are halls and courts to practice gymnastics and play handball, basketball and football for free. Tennis courts are also available in the campus.

The University physical health and recreation complex occupies a vast territory of 6500 m²: it's bigger part is 4 football courts (2 indoor) and 15 tennis courts. All the year round regardless of the weather students can do sport individually or join any of the 36 sport clubs. One of the University's traditions is organizing annual "Mini World Cups" in different team and individual sports.

There are international post-office, students' international cultural centre, telephone and computer centres, shops, several national cuisine restaurants, in the campus.

LANGUAGE

The language of study and communication is Russian. All students who don't speak Russian learn it for one year at the Faculty of Russian language and general educational disciplines (so called "preparatory faculty"). So every graduate has opportunity to get the second specialty with a separate diploma of interpreter.

For those who chose the English programs there are summer Russian language school (detailed information is available on <http://moscowsummerschool.ru>) and vocational Russian courses during academic year.

LIBRARY

Main Library stock consist of about 2,5 million books in many languages. There are several specialized libraries at the faculties. All students are provided with textbooks for free. Students can also use computer centre and library facilities to prepare to lectures.

VISA & MIGRATION MATTERS

The Russian diplomatic missions issue 3 months entry visa on receiving University's official invitation.

Residence permit is to be prolonged annually. Obligatory registration in Moscow can be prolonged for one year or whole study period for CIS citizens and till expiry of student visa for other foreigners.

Tickets to Moscow are available at regional offices of all leading international air companies.

The University International Office provides assistance and consultations on all matters linked to education process.

DOCUMENTS REQUIRED FOR ADMISSION

- education certificate or diploma (original)
- statement of results (transcript)
- application form
- proof of sponsorship from parents or organisation
- health and HIV test certificates (must confirm student's ability to study at a higher education institution)
- notarized copy of education certificate or diploma
- notarized copy of passport (page with photo)
- 7 photos (3x4 cm)

All documents of education must be legalized by a national Ministry of Education and by the Consular section of the Russian Embassy in your country.

FINANCE

Payment of tuition fees is to be done in compliance with a bill twice a year: at the beginning of the first semester in September and second semester in February.

International bank located in the campus offers private accounts and other services. It's advised to have \$ 300-350 order to meet monthly costs of meals, transport, clothes, private needs, etc.

Annual tuition fee for foreign students of the Faculty of Russian language and general educational disciplines (Preparatory Faculty) is \$4300 but for medical specialties (General Medicine and Dentistry) it's \$4900. For CIS students the cost is equal to the annual cost of studying on the main program.

PFUR-RSS EDUCATIVE-EXHIBITING COMPLEX (EEC)

Founded in cooperation with JSC "Russian Space Systems" with the purposes to design and adoption of global commercializing mechanisms of production and services of the Russian space industry.

EEC has access to the real-time information coming from the RSS Research Centre of the Earth on-line monitoring that gives opportunity to deal with issues in the following spheres:

- geological prospecting (mineral exploration);
- agriculture (detection of crop capacity for different plants, degree of soil aridity, presence of destructive insect);
- ecology (detection of pollution degree, forestry and water industry monitoring);
- medicine (medical and biological experiments aboard of the International Space Station, medical preflight cosmonauts' training, researches on influences of long term space flights on human health);
- transport and communication (provision of objects' geological positioning and monitoring);
- fast response to in natural disasters and emergencies (tsunamis, floods, earthquakes, etc.).

PFUR EDUCATIVE MISSION CONTROL CENTER

Spheres of cooperation

- Space services promotion

Spreading the information about services in the sphere of space activities with further negotiating on their acquisition and usage in the interests of private and government organizations with the aim of getting maximum benefit.

General scientific and educative direction

Inviting cosmonauts and considerable scientists as main lecturers for courses of lectures on space activities.

Production of low weight and size satellites

This project allows its participants to design and produce low weight and size satellites to carry certain equipment for implementing private business or government purposes, for example in mineral exploration, evaluation of ecological conditions, deforestation and water pollution monitoring.
