Dear Students

On behalf of Management and all CUT staff, we would like to wish you all strength and wisdom for the main assessment period that commences on Monday, 7 November 2016. Please use this opportunity to ensure success in your studies in order to secure a bright future for you.

Management has made every effort to ensure that students complete their final assessments. All reasonable security measures will be in place at both campuses to ensure a smooth assessment process, and to secure the safety of students, staff and property.
